At NAPC, we believe that comprehensive care is essential in maintaining good health.

The **Affordable Care Act (ACA)** was signed into law on March 23, 2010. This law requires insurance companies to cover all applicants with new standards for Preventative Health Care including a limited wellness visit, but does not include comprehensive physical or evaluation of acute or chronic illnesses.

There are 15 preventative services that are recommended for adults. Some of those items include immunizations, screening for depression, blood pressure screening, colorectal cancer screening for adults over 50 and cholesterol screening.

Annual Wellness Visit

G-Codes: G0402, G0438, G0439 (\$138 to \$210)

Limited review of your medical and family history. Does **not** include evaluation and treatment of any illness or symptoms.

Obtaining vital signs:

- Temperature
- Height
- Weight
- BMI
- Blood pressure
- Respiration rate
- Oxygen level

Review of your current medications

- It does **not** include medication refills, or any new medication prescriptions.

An Advanced Beneficiary Notice (ABN) will be provided. This is designed to help you understand your visit and what tests your provider has ordered.

✦ Chronic Care Management

- **Evaluation** of all chronic medical conditions and diagnoses.
- **Medication** Reconciliation and Refills.
- **Evaluation** of Lifestyle and Diet.
- Appropriate **diagnostic** and **lab testing**.
- **Coordinating care** with specialists.
- Developing **follow-up care** management plans.

✦ Acute Care Evaluation

- **Evaluation** of symptoms and any acute illness.
- Evaluation of any **abnormality** discovered at your physical or wellness exam.
- **Referral** to specialist for follow-up care.
- Appropriate **diagnostic** and **laboratory testing**.
- **Prescribing medications** and appropriate follow up.

Additional Information

The annual wellness **"FREE"** visit provided by Medicare and private insurance companies is very limited. It does not include most diagnostic testing and does not include treatment of chronic conditions or treatment of any acute illnesses.

Our providers follow evidence based medical guidelines from national medical organizations to individualize treatment plans and goals for you. As such, these services are likely covered by your health insurance policy; however, applicable co-pays, coinsurance and deductible may apply.

You will be asked to complete an **ADVANCED BENEFICIARY NOTICE (ABN)** prior to services being rendered. Please make sure you read this document and select an option to receive or to not receive the services suggested by your medical provider.

We highly recommend you contact your health insurance carrier to become familiar with your benefits. Any additional tests required during any wellness exam may not be covered under wellness, and may incur additional out of pocket expenses as explained above. Please make sure to contact your insurance carrier to obtain a listing of coverage details relating to your plan for all wellness and problem focused related visits.

✦ Patient Responsibility

Finally good healthcare requires your input.

Ask questions and communicate with both the doctor and nurse. Let them know your concerns and problems at the beginning of a visit.

Also, know YOUR health insurance benefits.

Providing quality healthcare at reasonable costs requires team work.
